

2019 Street Rehabilitation Weekly Construction Update 9/6/2019

Current Events

The Contractor has finished the installation of new sewer and watermains along Riviera Drive (McCallum Drive to 7th Street), Riviera Court, and along a portion of 7th Street SW.

Crews are also currently in the process of reconstructing the road section along Sunset Lane, 6th Street SW, 10th Avenue SW, 5th Street SW, and 9th Avenue SW.

Future Events

Next week crews will work to complete the following:

- Begin installation of new water services in areas where new watermain installation is complete.
- Install new sanitary sewer and watermain along the north end of McCallum Drive.
- Start laying out temporary water piping along Riviera Drive (Imperial Lane to McCallum Drive).
- Continue reconstructing the road section along Sunset Lane, 6th Street SW, 10th
 Avenue SW, 5th Street SW, and 9th Avenue SW.
- Install new curb and gutter in spot locations at intersections and along Sunset Lane, 6th Street SW, 10th Avenue SW, 5th Street SW, and 9th Avenue SW.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will do everything possible to minimize inconvenience to residents in the construction areas. Residents must realize, however, that this type of construction will generate noise, dust, and mud, and is generally a disruption to the area.

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their block.

It is very important that people drive slow and watch out for workers and equipment when in the construction areas. Driving slowly not only reduces accidents, but also reduces dust, which can be a problem during dry spells.
