

2019 Street Rehabilitation Weekly Construction Update 9/30/2019

Current Events

Paving on 5th Street - 6th Street - 9th Ave - 10th Ave - Sunset started today and should be complete in the next couple days.

It is anticipated that the remaining water service installation on Riviera up to McCallum will happen this week. After service work is complete in this section additional storm sewer pipes will be installed from Imperial towards Sunset.

The contractor will work with the residents living on McCallum to activate their temporary water service connections. Watermain work could begin this week.

Access

The existing clay soils and moisture make for a sloppy mess in your neighborhood. Staff is working with the contractor to import rock and they will continue to push/scrape mud off of the exposed areas to ease your pain. Please note that if you wish to know exactly where the contractor will be next, you can contact Steven at the number listed below. He is also onsite daily and drives a City of New Brighton vehicle for inspecting the contractors work.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will do everything possible to minimize inconvenience to residents in the construction areas. Residents must realize, however, that this type of construction will generate noise, dust, and mud, and is generally a disruption to the area.

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their block.

It is very important that people drive slow and watch out for workers and equipment when in the construction areas. Driving slowly not only reduces accidents, but also reduces dust, which can be a problem during dry spells.
