Cape May Harbor Village & Yacht Club Association Harbor Cove Block 1172 Lots 3.26 & 3.27 Subdivision Request

Craig Hurless clarified his credentials for the record.

Elizabeth Casey, Esquire with Briggs Law Office to represent the Association along with professional Vincent Orlando of Engineering Design Associates. Ms. Casey clarified the major subdivision approval of January 11, 2011 and requested Mr. Orlando to proceed with the request. Mr. Orlando stated the applicant seeks major subdivision approval to divide an existing lot 3.26 to separate Harbor Cove cartway from the open space so that the street may be accepted as a public right of way. Lot 3.28 will contain open space and the widening of Harbor Cove has been proposed to permit a total of 24 on street parking spaces with sufficient street width to conform to RSIS requirement. He concluded they would file the map prepared by Stephen Martinelli, Land Surveyor (the final subdivision plat) and submitted a supplemental plan by EDA with a revision date of June 10, 2011. George Neidig advised it should be noted for the record that City Council voted and approved by Resolution #115-05-2011 including Exhibits A & B.

Craig Hurless, Board Engineer updated the membership by summarizing his report dated June 28, 2011 and reiterated the applicant's proposal in his description encompassing the revisions. The Completeness review on pages 2 & 3 addressing the details for both Minor & Major Subdivisions as outlined in §445-17 & §445-18 of the City of Cape May Code itemizing map detail (s) and §445-34 (e) and (f). He addressed his Zoning Charts page 4 addressing R-1 District (§525-14). He clarified the zoning requirements proposal to create a public street right of way. Mr. Hurless continued with his General Review comments on pages 4 through 6 items; Zoning & Subdivision: #1, #2 (issue addressed), #3, #4 & #5, Grading, Drainage & Utilities: #6, #7, #8 (issue addressed) #9, #10, #11, Map Filing Review #12 (issue addressed), #13 (issue addressed), #14 (issue addressed), #15 (Parking bumpers), General Conditions & Other Jurisdictional requirements: #16, #17, #18, #19, #20 and #21.

Members were positive on the revisions of the plans commending the applicant and professionals.
