NOTICE OF INFORMATIONAL MEETING ON

PROPOSED 2019 STREET REHABILITATION

In 1980, the New Brighton City Council adopted a Comprehensive Street Plan for maintaining our aging street and alley system. The plan identifies needed maintenance and repair work to insure good serviceability and preservation of the City's street and alley investment. The plan is also used to identify older streets and alleys in need of replacement.

The streets in your neighborhood have been identified as needing replacement in 2019. The overall scope of the project will include pavement replacement, partial curb and gutter replacement, watermain replacement, hydrant replacement, and storm sewer upgrades. A map of the proposed project corridor can be found on the back of this mailing.

You and your neighbors are invited to attend an informal informational meeting to learn about this proposed project. The meeting will be held:


Your input at this meeting will be helpful to prepare a Feasibility Report that will be presented to the City Council. The Feasibility Report will include the need for the project and estimated costs.

The cost of the street replacement portion of the project is paid for in part by the City and in part by special assessments to the benefiting properties. The assessment procedures will be explained at the informational meeting. There will be no assessment to residents for utility repairs or improvements.

COMPREHENSIVE STREET PLAN




- City Council adopted plan for maintaining our streets and alley system.
- New Brighton has about 64 miles of streets and alleys.
- Streets are rehabilitated about every 25 to 30 years.
- Rehabilitate about 2.1 miles per year.
- 2019 Street Rehabilitation corridor originally projected for 2023.










STREET IMPROVEMENTS









- 2.81 miles of streets in project corridor
- Streets to be constructed to their original width
- Remove and replace bituminous pavement and base material
- Full replacement of curb and gutter in watermain replacement areas
- Partial replacement of curb and gutter in other areas
- Use of Type V Fabric or Geogrid





Water System Replacement For 2019 Street Reconstruction

WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

- Watermain and services in areas with a high break history will be replaced.
 - 12,000 feet of watermain
 - 230 water services
 - 46 watermain valves
 - 28 hydrants
- Any unused services to be abandoned at connection to main
- Water services with a history of freezing will be insulated


STORM SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS



- Install additional storm sewer along Riviera Drive
- Sediment removal from Imperial Pond
- Detention basin adjacent to Totem Pole Park
- Replace structures constructed of block





- Xcel Gas to install additional gas main throughout the project corridor (shown in yellow)
- Residential gas services will also be replaced

2019 Street Reconstruction - Assessment Breakdown



Single Family

- Assessment Method: Per Lot Basis
- Estimated Assessment: \$3,000 / Lot

Multi-Family

- Assessment Method: Per Address Basis
- Multiple Units Per Lot
- **Higher Density**

- Estimated Assessment: \$3,000 / Address

INFORMATIONAL MEETING - NOTES

Access to property

 Residents will have access to their driveways during construction, except when major construction activity is happening adjacent to their property.

On street parking

• The City asks that no one park on the street while construction is underway unless it is necessary due to curb or driveway replacement.

Water

• Specified areas of watermain will need to be shut down during replacement. Temporary water lines will be used during this time to supply residents with water.

Mail Service

 It is anticipated that temporary mail box clusters will need to be installed due to the amount of excavation needed during utility work.

Garbage / Recycling Services

Garbage and recycling service will continue as normal. Helpful to label garbage cans.


