



Ballot Count Observation Parameters

Who can observe the Ballot Count?

Candidates, or a representative of the candidate who presents a written authorization signed by the candidate.

A reasonable number of the general public is contingent on the size of the room. If the number of general public exceeds the space in the room, they will be rotated admission to the room for observation for a reasonable period of time to be determined by the Municipal Recorder.

Parameters

- * Observers will remain quiet and respectful of the counting process.
- * Interaction with election workers is prohibited in any manner.
- * Observers may have phones/cameras.
Phones must be silenced.
- * Observers may take notes.
- * Any questions regarding steps in the process of counting can be answered by the Municipal Recorder.
- * Concerns raised during and after the count, regarding the count accuracy, are not appropriate. Concerns should be noted and then raised at the canvassing.
