Announcement: Linda announced that Stacey Kendig, our Shepherd University representative, has resigned from the committee due to responsibilities at Shepherd. We talked about whether we need to replace her with another SU representative or just continue to work closely with the Age-Friendly Shepherd University group.

### Old Business:

1. AARP Grant. Most of the meeting involved updates and plans related to the AARP Community Challenge grant we initiated. Leigh Ann gave a detailed progress report on what had transpired since our last committee meeting. We talked about what to expect at the Town Council meeting scheduled later that day.
2. Ice and snow removal. We learned that Gino has one or more interns who are collecting data about what transpired this past winter. We heard directly from Hunter, one of the interns who has been involved with this effort.
3. Bike Route. Marty reported that the needed signage was not yet in place. Some recently installed pole signs are in the wrong places. Also, many sharrows on the streets have started to disappear. Marty will continue to work with Woody to ensure adequate signage is in place as soon as possible.
4. Action plan revision. Linda had no news to report on this work.

### New Business:

1. Change of committee leadership. Linda reported that she and Marty would be moving out of town early in the summer, after Marty has fulfilled his term on council. She is eager to find someone to take over the leadership of the Age

Friendly Shepherdstown Committee. She has asked Leigh Ann who is considering it.
