7. <u>Daniel DeSimone</u> 252 Brooklake Road **Application #BOA25-5**

Block 2002, Lot 23

Applicant is seeking approval for excess improved lot coverage and a two-foot grade increase in connection with a proposed pool and patio project.

Carried from the August 6, 2025 without further notice or publication.

Daniel DeSimone remained under oath. He said he worked with his professional to try to reduce the lot coverage and still keep the Brooklake Road driveway. They realized that there was no practical way to reduce that driveway and have it still be functional.

As a result, they removed the Brooklake driveway completely. They created a K-turn area on the Crescent Road driveway and constructed a walkway to the front door from that area. This change resulted in a new lot coverage amount of 32.8%. This is only slightly larger than what exists today.

Mr. DeSimone provided the Board with engineer plans that explain how he drywell capacity would be increased to accommodate any additional runoff.

Mr. Noss asked about the Brooklake Road driveway opening by the street and how that would be closed. Mr. Novalis said that he took a look at that and saw that the Belgian block curbing is depressed all along Brooklake Road and the curbing along his driveway opening was never removed. The curbing exists today and matches what is along the road.

Mr. Cannilla stated that he appreciates all the effort and changes to the project that Mr. DeSimone made. Mr. DeSimone was cooperative throughout the process and Mr. Cannilla thought the result was a better project. Mr. Cannilla felt that it was reasonable to have the resolution reflect a lot coverage increase not to exceed 33%.

There were no questions or comments from Board members or the public. Mr. Cannilla asked for a motion on the application.

Mr. Facas made a motion to approve the application and adopt the resolution reflecting the approved lot coverage not to exceed 33%, second by Mr. O'Connor
