**Meeting Minutes**  
**June 23, 2025**

**Call to Order:** Chairman Michael Audette called the scheduled June 23, 2025, Municipal Facilities Ad-Hoc Committee Meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. at Plymouth Town Hall, Assembly Room, 80 Main Street, Terryville, Connecticut.

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**New Business:**

**a. Planning for open hearing on September 3, 2025**

Chairman Audette reported the referendum date will take place two weeks after the public hearing. However, the date has not been set.

Vice-Chairwoman Ann Marie Rheault wants an information flyer mailed out to the residents. The video posted needs to be edited in the beginning and the end.

A discussion took place about what the town can advertise prior to the referendum date being set. Once the referendum date is set, the town must be quiet.

The police union needs to be ready to send something out once the referendum date is set.

Committee Member/Sergeant Cesar Beiros talked about having an event with a food trucks or the officers grilling to get the word out and have the residents tour the police station.

Vice-Chairwoman Rheault suggested inviting Brian Humes and a representative from Downes Construction to the September 3<sup>rd</sup> public hearing.

There will be 2 separate questions -  
\$21,000,000 for police station  
\$6,000,000 for roads

Chairman Audette will ask the mayor:

- For money to mail out a flyer.
- What the Plymouth department can and cannot say?
- What the police union can and cannot say?
- What is the tax increase?

The Committee will meet on July 28<sup>th</sup>. The mayor and finance director will be invited to that meeting.

The Committee discussed advertising strategies: YouTube channel and doing a voice over to go along with their pdf presentation.


