RESOLUTION OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD TO ADJUST SCOPE OF SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Nyack Village Board has previously discussed the scope of the Safe Routes to School sidewalk expansion and improvement project in the vicinity of Depew Ave, most recently at its meeting on May 26;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the expansion of sidewalks requires the removal of a range of amenities belonging to property owners, such as hedges, fences, trees and retaining, walls, the approximate total cost of restoration of these amenities is almost \$184,000;

WHEREAS, the amenity restoration costs can be funded within the NYS DOT grant project if they are included in the sidewalk construction project, likely to occur in 2023;

WHEREAS, the Nyack Village Board desires to direct grant funding toward these restoration costs, and identify equal offsetting construction costs to avoid in order to keep the overall project cost within budget;

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator provided an analysis of possible cuts to project scope to offset increased amenity restoration costs, reviewed these options with the Village Board on May 26th and with the community via a public video conference on Wednesday, June 1 at 7 pm;

WHEREAS, of the various options considered, the removal of the sidewalk improvements on S. Franklin St and lower Main St, specifically eleven sidewalk corner upgrades to ADA compliant ramped corners, was deemed to have the least negative impact on the overall goal of the project, that goal being providing safer walking conditions for students living in the vicinity of Depew Ave and upper Main Street;

WHEREAS, the proposed removal of the eleven ADA corners would maintain intact the sidewalk replacement plans for Depew Ave (Franklin to Rte 9w, as well as Upper Depew), Summit St, and a segment of Main St from Midland Ave west to Bethel Alliance Church;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD AS FOLLOWS: the scope of the Safe Routes to School project is adjusted to include the costs of amenity restoration, which additional unanticipated cost will be offset by the removal of the costs of construction of 11 ADA
