5. Discuss and possibly vote on an Ordinance to amend Article II §65-24 of the municipal code of the Town of Dewey Beach relating to the beach concessions contract and removing the handling of trash by the beach concessions vendor.
6. Discuss and possibly vote on an Ordinance to amend Article II §93-5 of the municipal code of the Town of Dewey Beach relating to parking permits and the elimination of the **daily and** four-hour minimum rates.
