AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 21 ENFORCEMENT AND CONTROL OF VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CONCERNING §21-6(C) PEDICAB VEHICLE PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, the Town of Dewey Beach has examined fees within the Code and determined that simplification is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach have concluded that there is insufficient justification for classifying pedicab license fees differently than other licensed businesses referred to in §117-13B of the code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach, Sussex County, Delaware, in session met, as follows:

Section 1. Amend §21-6C(3) of the Code of Ordinances as depicted by highlighted insertions, strikeouts, and substitutions depicted below:

C. Pedicab vehicle permit. Every operator or owner of a pedicab shall have a vehicle permit and display a decal issued by the Town on the upper rear panel of the vehicle. Every operator or owner must have a vehicle permit and decal for each pedicab vehicle operated or owned. Vehicle permits and decals are valid for one year from the date of issuance and are not transferable. A vehicle permit and decal shall be issued upon providing the following:

- (1) Proof that the operator is at least 18 years old;
- (2) A valid and unaltered insurance policy that provides coverage as detailed in this section, and provides coverage for all employees, agents and lessees; ~~and~~.
- ~~(3) A processing fee of \$25 for each permit.~~

Section 2. If any provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed or held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, then such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance which may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by a majority vote of the Commissioners of the Town of Dewey Beach.

SYNOPSIS

This Act deletes the pedicab processing fee from §21-6C of the code, with the intention of classifying pedicab licenses as either an in-town or out-of-town business as outlined in §117-13B of the code.
