

**§ 185-16. Governmental exemptions. [Amended 1-11-2014 by Ord. No. 708]**

- A. Governmental functions of the United States, State of Delaware, Sussex County and any other federal, state or county agency are subject to the provisions of the Municipal Code of the Town of Dewey Beach. Governmental functions of the Town of Dewey Beach are exempt from the provisions of the Municipal Code of the Town of Dewey Beach except where these functions may be located within the flood-prone areas (including FEMA-designated VE, AE and AO flood zones) as determined by the FEMA maps and designations. Government functions of the United States, State of Delaware, and Sussex County in which the Town of Dewey Beach participates financially and/or contractually are exempt from the provisions of this Code, including but not limited to the functions of water supply systems and sanitary sewer systems.
- B. The provisions of the chapter apply except where these functions are located within the flood-prone areas (including FEMA-designated VE, AE and AO flood zones). In addition to such functions as are deemed governmental, the following shall also be deemed to be governmental: water systems, sewer systems, functions of water and sewer districts created pursuant to 9 Del. C. Ch. 65 and Ch. 67, and solid waste disposal or transfer facilities.
