**§71-3 Building permits.**

G. Building permits shall be valid for one year from date of issue, and may be renewed one time for one additional year ~~for a fee of \$50, provided renewal is applied for prior to expiration date, except in extraordinary circumstances, an additional renewal may be allowed subject to Commissioners approval.~~ Projects for which the permit has expired will require a new permit based on a current construction cost estimate before continuing any work on the project. [Added 7-15-1988 by Ord. No. 121; amended 9-12-1992 by Ord. No. 245]

**§185-80 Building permits; fee**

C. Building permits shall be valid for one year from date of issue, and may be renewed one time for one additional year, provided renewal is applied for prior to expiration date, on each anniversary date thereafter for the fee of \$50. Failure to renew shall void the permit. Projects for which the permit has expired will require a new permit based on a current construction cost estimate before continuing any work on the project.
