The parking lot area of The Starboard Restaurant will be fenced off by barricades and fencing approved by the Delaware ABCC. Portable bathrooms will be brought in the morning of the event, and removed the same evening. This event will run from 9am-5pm on said Saturday, though music and service ends by 4pm, we request till 5pm to allow time for clean up. State Police are brought in to assist with crowds & traffic control. DELDOT is on hand handling traffic as well. There is a fantastic working effort on the coordination taken and effort to pull this off. We will again place up 20 volunteers on the street with trash bags and bottled water to maintain crowds/trash.

12th Annual Dewey Goes Pink 5K Expansion of Premise 2023, Saturday, Oct 7, 2023

In our 12th year, an event that is a marquee fall attraction to our small town with over 4000 participants this past year, we request the use of our parking lot area (and Saulsbury Street) to host the pig roast portion of the fundraiser for Delaware Breast Cancer Coalition. We will provide fence barricades approved by the Delaware ABCC & portable toilets. The race begins at 11am, and entire area will be cleaned up and over by 5pm same evening. DE State Police and DELDOT are both on hand to assist with this event each year. Total raised now in the first 11 years surpasses \$1,200,000.00 for the DBCC.
