

### **Improvements the town has made to the crosswalks for public safety:**


- 1**-worked with DelDot and the State Legislature to lower the speed limit in town to 25mph on RT 1
- 2**-added 10 additional pedestrian crosswalk signs on RT 1 and on King Charles Highway at the crosswalks
- 3**-added 16 additional pedestrian crosswalk markings on RT 1 before the crosswalks
- 4**-stenciled "LOOK TWICE CHECK BOTH LANES" in **RED** on the sidewalks at all crosswalk crossings
- 5**-stenciled "PUSH BUTTON" in **RED** on all sidewalks at the crosswalks
- 6**-the town with DelDot installed the post and ropes on the center island of RT 1 in an effort to have the public go to the crosswalks
- 7**-on RT 1 extended a 50' solid white line down the center of the road before the crosswalks so cars don't change lanes
- 8**-the Town purchased and installed two radar speed sign boards at the north end and south end of town in an effort to slow down traffic entering Dewey
- 9**-the police have conducted speed and crosswalk enforcement
- 10**-the Town has removed some of the trees on the center island and will continue to trim them

### **Continuing to improve public safety:**

- extending the post and ropes (Dewey Wave) from Read to Collins Ave and from Salisbury Street to Clayton Street this winter
- the town has asked DelDot this fall/winter to lower the yellow flash beacons in the center island so it will increase their visibility to drivers
- the town will be removing some trees from the center island this fall to improve public safety at the crosswalks
- the town will be purchasing a portable message board that will warn drivers of the crosswalks and the fine \$\$\$ for not stopping for pedestrians in the crosswalks
