Amendments Related to Use of Tents and Canopies on the Beach

In 1-16. Definitions, amend or add as indicated:

CANOPY

A portable or detachable, open-sided, roof-like cover supported from the ground, deck, or floor or walls of a building for protection from sun or weather.

BABY TENT

A portable, pop-up shelter, no larger than 36" x 36" x 36", which is enclosed and designed to provide a safe and comfortable outdoor space for babies and young children.

In Article I Ocean Beach Use and Activities, add

65-11. Use of Tents and Canopies

A. Tents, other than baby tents, are not permitted on the beach.

B. Use of canopies on the beach is permitted,

1. The area covered by a canopy shall be no larger than 12 feet by 12 feet.
2. A canopy may be placed no closer than 15 feet behind the line of lifeguard chairs along the beach.
3. A canopy shall be placed no closer than 10 feet from any other canopy.
4. Canopies shall not be placed on the beach before 9:00 AM.

In Article III Beach and Baywalk, insert the following in 65-31 and renumber succeeding paragraphs:

T. Use of Tents and Canopies

A. Tents, other than baby tents, are not permitted on the beach.

B. Use of canopies on the beach is permitted,

1. The area covered by a canopy shall be no larger than 12 feet by 12 feet.
2. A canopy may be placed no closer than 15 feet behind the line of lifeguard chairs along the beach.
3. A canopy shall be placed no closer than 10 feet from any other canopy.
4. Canopies shall not be placed on the beach before 9:00 AM.
