4 **A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE USE OF INFRASTRUCTURE ACCOUNT FUNDS TO EXECUTE A FLOOD**
5 **MITIGATION PROJECT ON DICKINSON AVENUE BAYSIDE**

6 **WHEREAS**, the Town’s Comprehensive Plan asserts the importance of reducing bayside flooding
7 and removing pollutants from flood waters prior to discharge into the Rehoboth Bay; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Town has identified recurring tidal flooding at the bayside end of Dickinson
9 Avenue caused by backflow through the existing stormwater inlet; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Beacon Engineering’s proposed Dickinson Street Drainage Improvements Project is
11 intended to mitigate such flooding by installing a tide gate that will allow stormwater runoff to discharge
12 to the Bay while preventing tidal backflow; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the scope of work will include dewatering and management of bay water within this
14 portion of the collection system, excavation, backfill, and compaction to install a precast concrete vault
15 adjacent to the existing inlet; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the precast concrete vault will be designed to house the automatic tide gate and
17 provide personnel access for periodic cleaning and maintenance to ensure uninterrupted operation; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the engineering design and construction cost for the project is estimated to be
19 between \$61,500 and \$71,500; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Dewey Beach Infrastructure Committee met on August 12, 2025 to review the
21 details of this project, and recommended to the Town Council [PENDING]; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Town seeks to undertake these improvements to protect public infrastructure,
23 reduce property impacts, and improve stormwater system reliability.

24 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council that the Town of Dewey
25 Beach hereby approves the use of a maximum of \$71,500 from the Town Infrastructure Account to
26 complete the Dickinson Avenue Flood Mitigation Project proposed by Beacon Engineering.
