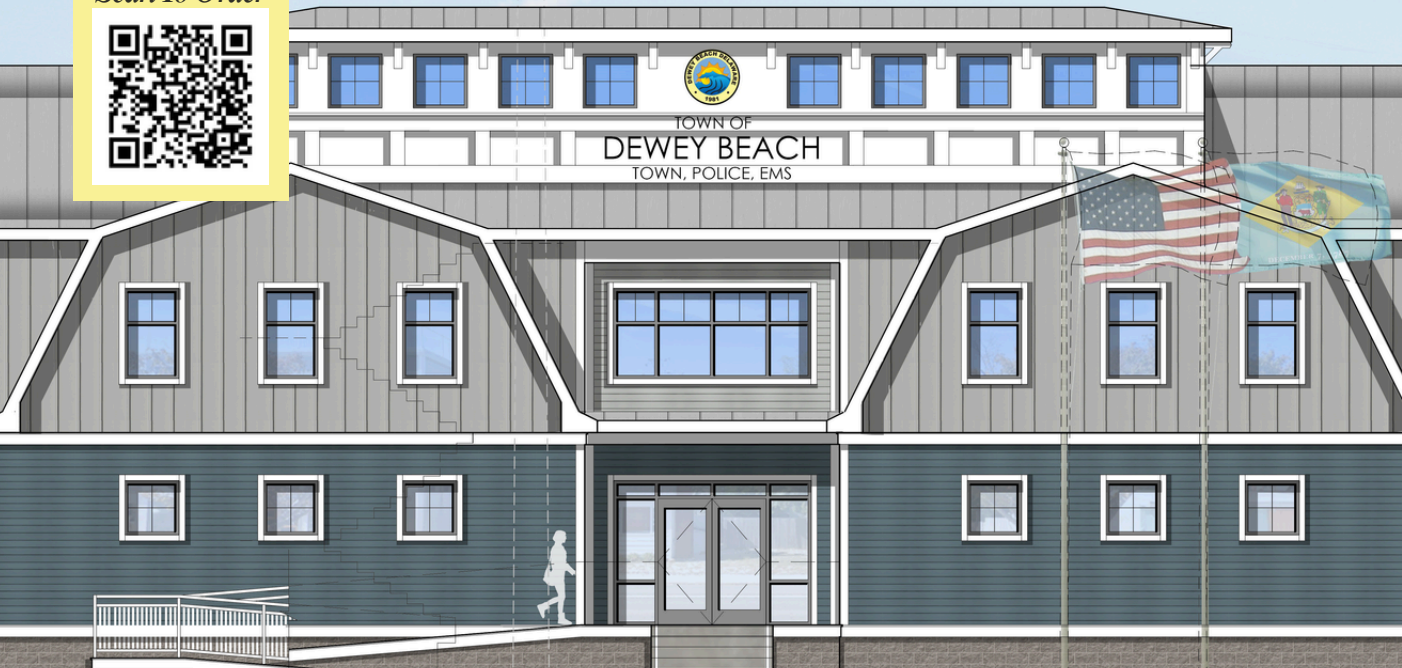


## *Pave the Way*

## The Project

The new Dewey Beach Town Hall will be more than just a home for local government. It will also serve as a modern Public Safety Building, bringing essential services together under one roof. In addition to housing Town offices, the facility will provide dedicated space for the Dewey Beach Police Department, Parking Authority, Alderman Court, and Sussex County EMS. This centralized hub will strengthen community safety, improve efficiency, and provide residents and visitors with a welcoming and functional space that reflects Dewey Beach's commitment to progress and public service.

The new Dewey Beach Town Hall and Public Safety Building, located at 1505 Coastal Highway, will feature a wide walking path along the south side of the building. This inviting pathway will not only provide easy access for the public from the parking area on Rodney Avenue, but also serve as the permanent home for the engraved bricks purchased through our fundraiser. Each brick will become part of this lasting walkway, creating a meaningful place where community pride and personal stories are built right into the foundation of our town's future.
