## **Questions for Department Heads**

**CEDEI KNOWLEDGE Questions for Heads of Departments:** 

We would like to start our process by first listening and learning from you about DEI in Cape Elizabeth.

How would you recommend we learn more from you and staff in your department about DEI related challenges? Could you name 2-3 town staff/officials/committee members that we should start with?

How has prior research/surveys gone with your department in the past? What has worked, not worked? Going forward, would your department be open to responding to an online survey?

## **Knowledge (Charge C) SMARTIE Goals**

Action 1: Elevate voices and DEI related experiences of front-line town **employees** through meetings (2x dept heads), in-depth interviews with selected individuals from each department (#TBD), an online survey (>50% response rate) and engaging selected employees in leading roles to develop subsequent town survey questions.

Action 2: Elevate voices and DEI related experiences of **residents** through 25 interviews with individuals from marginalized groups, while selecting a few to serve to lead development of a subsequent town survey in collaboration with selected town staff. Then, a town-wide resident survey administered through accessible methods will reflect a representative proportion of all groups in Cape Elizabeth. In parallel, a Dear John/Love Letter initiative will answer more open-ended questions about the pros and cons of living in Cape Elizabeth.

Action 3: TBD at the end of the year, strategic plan development once research is complete.
