

Recycling Center Permits

Residential permits are issued at the Recycling Center and at the Cape Elizabeth Police Department. These permits also serve as a parking permit for Fort Williams Park and Portland Head Light.

Individuals must provide proof of seasonal or year round residency (vehicle registration plus utility bill, tax bill or rental agreement) to the attendant.

Contractors wishing to utilize the Recycling Center should contact the Public Works Department for information on applicable permits and fees.

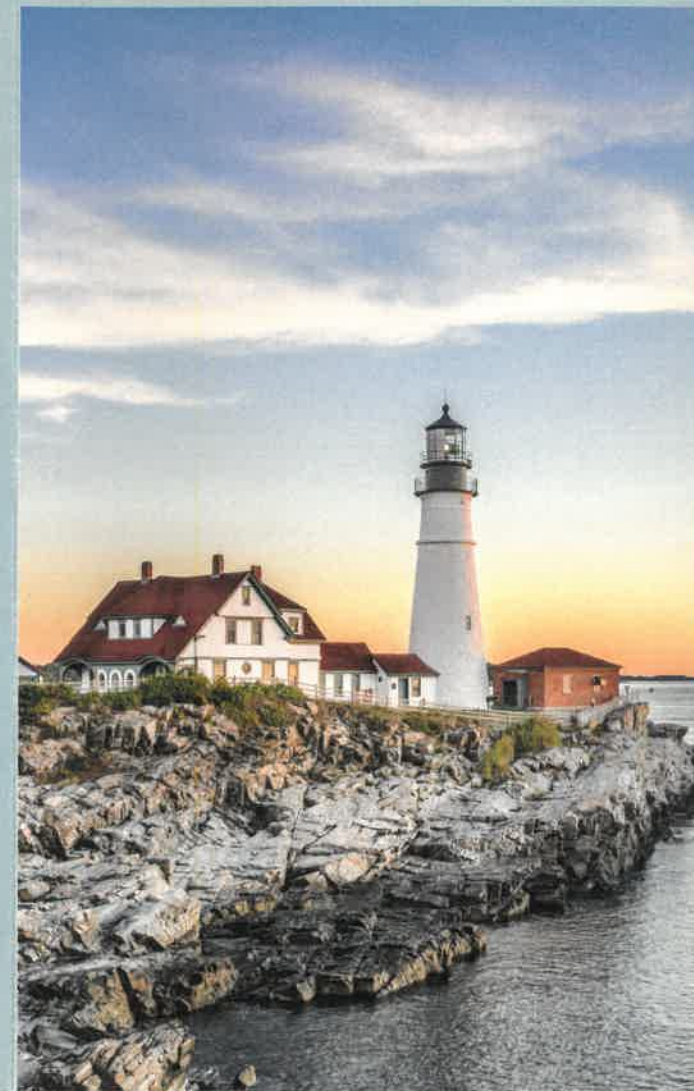
