Please find the following list of potential Recycling Committee goals for 2021. These items were identified at the committee's January 7, 2021 meeting:

- Research and secure a grant for water bottle filling stations at public facilities.
- Continue to engage the School District to work towards the following:
  - Increasing recycling efforts within the schools.
  - Educating students on recycling/composting/food waste diversion.
  - Engage the school planning committee with regards to proposed building designs that incorporate plans to make recycling easier and more consistent.
- Provide education and community outreach on recycling utilizing various strategies, such as:
  - Social media,
  - Networking with various local and regional recycling groups,
  - 'Community conversations', community events, and other resources.
- Provide recommendation to the Town Council to endorse NRCM's EPR Packaging legislation.
- Participate in the online Municipal Measurement Program; or recommend/encourage that Ecomaine participates on a regional level.
- Encourage school student participation with the recycling committee; and/or, Encourage school student membership to the recycling committee when vacancies arise.
