Hello Maureen,

As we discussed via phone a few minutes ago, I am including some materials that can be used as discussion points during the upcoming Conservation Committee meeting on the 8th of June.

I am proposing to identify, plan and possibly lead remediation of invasive plant infestations that have emerged along the woodland border of town woods and the adjacent Blueberry Ridge neighborhood that began development in 2005. The level of invasive infestation is low, a perfect time to address before it can grow to become more extensive and costly to remove.
