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Goal implementation status:

Items in the first category are all ongoing.

Items in second category:

- a. Comp plan implementation is ongoing
- b. Sawyer Road culvert study is ongoing, in collaboration with Scarborough and with a State grant.
- c. Kettle Cove access is ongoing with a planning grant, and access grant will be pursued.

Items in third category:

- a. Revenue creation with FWP Pay and Display revenues
- b. Senior Citizen Tax Relief program is successful in year two and growing.
- c. Town Center investment growing with additions to tax base, new sidewalks planned in Town Center.

Items in fourth category:

- a. Multiple forums on pay and display parking at FWP.
- b. Website redevelopment and re-launch underway.
- c. Continued response to citizen inquiries, council and manager.

Items in fifth category:

- a. Agenda format is standardized and available on the Town website.

Items in sixth category:

- a. Discussions on long range planning for Fire Department are ongoing as volunteering has declined and need for more specialized training.
- b. Fort Williams Park master plan is planned for this year, discussion beginning tomorrow evening.
- c. Community Services programming is growing, senior citizen programming is increasing in volume of offerings and well subscribed.
- d. Spurwink School redevelopment / status updating.
- e. Sidewalk improvements in Town center planned, Scott Dyer Road improvements greatly enhancing mobility in Town center with sidewalk access from Ocean House Road to Spurwink Road.
