BUDGET WORKSHOP - MINUTES

Public Comment - *No members of the public spoke.*

Building Project Referendum Timeline Discussion - Superintendent Record asked the Board to consider the options for 1) referendum placement in either June or November, and 2) whether or not to invest in the schematic design in advance of the referendum.

Having a schematic design available early would be useful in providing more tangible information to voters, in addition to helping get the best final product. The schematic design cost, even if done early, would be included within the total project amount on the referendum. Bond counsel is being consulted.

A Board vote to approve the schematic design financing could be placed on the March Business Meeting and would need to be followed by a Town Council vote in April.

After Board discussion, Superintendent Record was asked to prepare the March Business Meeting agenda to include consideration to approve the financing for a Colby Company Engineering schematic design to be provided prior to the Project's placement on the November referendum.

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In 2017, the Cape Elizabeth School Board initiated an RFP to study its existing facilities. More information about the Building Project can be found on the website - https://www.cape.k12.me.us/page/building-committee

With 11.3 (FTE) employees, Cape Elizabeth school nutrition department is currently serving an average of 18,300 meals/month. Pre-pandemic the average was 3,500 meals/month. Cape Elizabeth and Scarborough Schools have an agreement to share the Director of Nutrition position.
