- 2. Continued Review of School Board FY23 Budget Questions & District Leadership Team (DLT) responses [Q & A document link] -

In Middle School Principal *Troy Eastman*'s absence, *Superintendent Record* responded to previously submitted Board questions related to the experiential learning program development and the CEMS budget presentation. [@  $\sim$  15:19 mins]

- 3. **Review of Use of Fund Balance** Finance Director Marcia Weeks provided an overview of fund balance related terminology and state and auditor requirements. Superintendent Record demonstrated the fund balance concept through an example household budget. The proposed unassigned fund balance percentage was 4.82%. A fund balance analysis and three-year projection was also introduced. (Fund Balance presentation March 22, 2022) [@ ~ 29:04 mins]
- 4. Discussion on target percentage increase on expenditures and percentage increase on taxes Finance Chair Phil Saucier opened the discussion. Superintendent Record said, to date, only one Cumberland County community [Yarmouth] school board had an approved expenditure and tax rate. With so many unknowns, the Superintendent will plan to come to the April 5th budget meeting with some options and recommendations for the Board's consideration. [@ ~ 53:31 mins]
