

**ORDINANCE NO. 3196**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DARBY, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THAT PART OF CERTAIN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATIONS ALLOCATED BY THE 2025 OPERATING BUDGET BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT TO VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS INCONSISTENT HEREWITH**

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**WHEREAS**, there exists certain unencumbered appropriations allocated by the 2025 Operating Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 909(D) of the Home Rule Charter of Upper Darby Township, the Mayor has requested that parts of certain unencumbered appropriations be transferred from the general government to various departments, offices and agencies within the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Township of Upper Darby, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That a certain portion of the unencumbered appropriation allocated by the 2025 Operating Budget shall be transferred from the general government to various departments, offices and agencies within the Township, as follows:

**SECTION 2.** If any section, sentence, clause, or word of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not prevent, preclude or otherwise foreclose the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the specific terms enacted hereby, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed.

**SECTION 4.** Pursuant to the Upper Darby Home Rule Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the signature of the Mayor or, in the event the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes this Resolution, fifteen days after the last day on which the Mayor can approve or veto this Resolution, as set forth in the Upper Darby Township Home Rule Charter, Section C-702.C.
