RESOLUTION NO. 9-26

**A RESOLUTION OF UPPER DARBY TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION
WITH THE DELAWARE VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION'S
("DVRPC") TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE
("TCDI") FY 2027 PENNSYLVANIA GRANT PROGRAM; REPEALING ALL
INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS OR PART THEREOF; PROVIDING A
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Darby ("Township") is a Home Rule Municipality organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Community Development Initiative ("TCDI") of the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission ("DVRPC") is a funding opportunity for local planning initiatives that have a transportation nexus and that also advance the goals of the regions long-range plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of Upper Darby Township ("Township Council") desires to authorize the submission of a grant application for fiscal year 2027 for a feasibility study and/or preliminary engineering plan for the connection between Upper Darby Township's proposed Naylor's Run Trail and Haverford Township's Pennsy Trail, both of which are identified on DVRPC's Circuit Trails program.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Upper Darby Township Council, and it is hereby **ADOPTED** and **RESOLVED** by authority of same as follows:

1. Upper Darby Township shall submit a grant application with DVRPC's TCDI program for fiscal year 2027, for the purposes set forth herein.
2. The proper officers are hereby authorized to take such steps as may be necessary to implement the intent of this Resolution.
3. All resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
4. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Resolution is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Resolution.
5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the signature of the Mayor or, in the event the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes this Resolution, fifteen days after the last

day on which the Mayor can approve or veto this Resolution, as set forth in the Upper Darby Township Home Rule Charter, Section C-702.C.
