ORDINANCE NO. 02-2022

PASSED: January 3, 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER \$600,000.00 FROM THE 2022 PERMANENT ANNUAL BUDGET GENERAL FUND (101) TO THE POLICE FUND (220) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, funds are needed to operate police operations for 2022 fiscal year.

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Newcomerstown, County of Tuscarawas, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Village of Newcomerstown, Ohio, authorizes the Fiscal Officer to transfer Six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) from the General Fund (101) to the Police Fund (220), this is a single 2022 annual authorization only.

SECTION 2: Upon passage of this ordinance all other Ordinance inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Village Council., and that all deliberations of the Village council and were in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of the Village of Newcomerstown, Ohio and for the further reason that in order to maintain proper and adequate operations at the cemetery department, additional funds are necessary.

SECTION 4: Wherefore, the Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
