ORDINANCE NO. 5-2022

ORDINANCE REGARDING RESTRICTING PARKING LIMITS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEWCOMERSTOWN,
OHIO

WHEREAS, the Village of Newcomerstown is responsible for preserving the health, safety and welfare of all residents AND visitors of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has found that current ordinances are not sufficient to allow Village officials to respond to this growing problem of parking in certain areas of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEWCOMERSTOWN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: Parking in violation of duly erected signs.

Whenever signs are erected by the Village pursuant to an ordinance or resolution of the village council or order by the mayor which establishes limited time parking zones or in any way limits or restricts parking, no person shall park, stop, or stand a vehicle in violation of the provisions indicated on such signs.

SECTION 2: Fines and Penalties

When the Village Mayor, Police Chief, or their designated agent determines that such violations described in this ordinance exist, he/she shall enforce this ordinance and may result in the following enforcement actions:

1 st offense	\$10
2 nd offense within 90 days	\$15
3 rd offense within 90 days	\$25
