WHEREAS, the total appropriations in the 2021 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement and public assistance, is the sum of \$20,534,259.54, and

WHEREAS, 26.25% of the total appropriations in the 2021 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement and public assistance in said budget is the sum of \$5,390,259.54.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sea Isle City, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that the following appropriations as detailed in appendix A be made and a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Chief Financial Officer for the record:
