A. Mayor's Update: We received close-out documents from the architects. We still need to pull the insurance total to forward to NCORR. The board will need to have a closed session with an attorney other than David Baxter to address issues from previous closed session. We will hold the first July meeting on Monday the 11th instead of the 12th in order to accommodate the other attorney. The motion to reschedule was made by Commissioner Henderson. Commissioner Robles seconded the motion and all were in favor. The re-dedication event went very well. The town received good press and had about 65 people in attendance. NCEM will bring in engineers to look at elevating buildings as part of the NCEM grant. Commissioner Barbee thanked

everyone for their help with Pollapalooza. The event was well attended. EEG project design documents have been received and construction documents are forthcoming. NCEM grant paperwork is underway. Mayor Bender met with Danny Meadows of Draper Arden about sending effluent to New Bern. The plan is still in the talking stage. Other parties have expressed that they will be interested only if the project is fully funded. The mayor contacted the engineers about drainage issues to be funded by Golden Leaf funds. Mayor Bender and Johnnie Chadwick met with emergency management to prepare for hurricane season. Derek Remer, liaison from Duke Energy, stopped by and said that he would try to support us whenever possible.
