

Our office is in receipt of an application for a "Multi-Residential Water and Sewer System Approval" in which the applicant is seeking LTMUA Preliminary and Final Approval to furnish sanitary sewer service to a re-development proposal of 0.32-acrc lot in the Diamond Beach portion of the Township. The subject parcel is situated between Memphis and Rochester Avenues while fronting Pacific Avenue and currently contains a two story office building with a single sewer service. The development will include the construction of two(2) tri-plex housing units, one fronting each side street, for a total of six(6) new living units. Public water service will be provided by the City of Wildwood Water Utility.

The following items have been submitted with the application:

- (1) Completed applications for preliminary and final Multi-Residential- Water and Sewer System Approval executed by applicant on 02/20/25
- (2) Drawings titled Site Plan For LJKQ Real Estate, NJ, prepared by EDA associates dated 011/25/24, signed by Joseph H Maffei, PE- 8 Sheets total

I. Project Description

The applicant is proposing to install a 6" single sanitary lateral service to each tri-plex building

In accordance with LTMU Λ policy the two(2) laterals are shown to be located outside the driveway and sidewalk areas.

II. Sanitary Review (Administrative)

- 1) The six (6) living units require one (1) allocation fee per unit. The current allocation fee is \$1,600.00.
- 2) The applicant currently holds one (1) commercial allocation fee, which will be credited against the required allocation fees for the new residential units.
- 3) The applicant will therefore need to purchase five (5) additional residential allocation fees, which equates to a current cost of \$8,000.00

III. Sanitary Sewer Review (Drawings)

- 1) The Authority requires separate lateral services to each living unit. The drawings shall be revised to show six(6) new 4" service laterals. All laterals <u>must</u> be located outside driveway and sidewalk areas
- 2) The existing sanitary lateral servicing the office building which connects to the Pacific Avenue gravity sewer main shall be excavated and capped at the main connection point prior to demolition of the office building. Notation and/or details shall be added to the drawing specifying this requirement
- 3) Add notation to Sewer Lateral Detail on sheet 7 of the drawings indicating that lateral connections to existing mains shall be completed utilizing saddle connections

IV. Permits

1) The applicant is responsible to obtain necessary street opening permits from the Township of Lower

V. General Requirements

- 1) The applicant shall post inspection fees in the amount of \$3,000.00. Amount to be placed in the applicant's escrow account.
- 2) Inspection services will require 48-hour notice to the Engineer's office. Inspecting engineer must be notified of installation of all lateral improvements,
- 3) At the completion of construction and prior to release of remaining escrow funds the applicant shall provide the Authority with digitally recorded information with all sewer elements tied to the Authority's GIS database.

Subject to the Applicant's agreement to satisfy any outstanding technical issues stated herein and subject to the following conditions, we recommend the Authority grant preliminary and conditional final Commercial/Industrial Water and Sewer approval.


