WHEREAS, on October 5, 2024 the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("Authority"), in accordance with the New Jersey Water Supply Public-Private Contracting Act (the "Act"), N.J.S.A. 58:26-19, et. seq., published a Notice of Intent to Enter Into a Contract and made available to interested vendors a Request for Proposals for Providing Full-Service Water Storage Tank Asset Management and Maintenance Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2024, in response to the published Request for Proposals, the Authority received one proposal, which was submitted by Utility Service Co., Inc.; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Act, on November 20, 2024 a Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Cape May County Herald, and on November 21, 2024 that same Notice was published in The Press of Atlantic City; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Act, a public hearing on the proposal submitted by Utility Service Co, Inc. was conducted on December 4, 2024 at which time the Authority's Board of Commissioners considered the testimony of the Authority's Executive Director by which the Executive Director explained the proposal and described the benefits to be derived from entering into a long-term asset management contract relative to its four water storage tanks pursuant to the terms and conditions as proposed by Utility Service Co.; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority desires to make application to the Local Finance Board for its review and/or approval of a proposed asset management Contract with Utility Service Co., Inc for the purpose of authorizing a Full-Service Water Storage Tank Asset Management and Maintenance Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority believes:

- (a) It is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose;
- (b) Said purpose is for the health, wealth, welfare, convenience and betterment of the customers of the Authority and the residents of the Township of Lower;

WHEREAS, the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("Authority" or "LTMUA") has a need to acquire professional financial consultant services from a certified public accountant having experience in providing such services to local governmental entities in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Stephen P. Testa, CPA, RMA of the firm of Romano Hearing Testa & Knorr of Vineland, NJ has the credentials and abilities to perform such services as are required by the Authority and has acted as the Authority's financial consultant for a number of years; and

- (E) The individual or entity who will provide these services has demonstrated competence and particular expertise in the services required;
- (F) The individual or entity who will perform these services is held to and fully adheres to the strict ethical standards that govern the involved profession;
- (G) The services include advice to and consultation with the municipality that require both knowledge and judgment on the part of the individual or entity providing services, as well as the confidence of the municipal officials, such that competitive bidding is not feasible or practical;
- (H) The services to be provided are such that their nature, scope and duration are not capable of precise measurement, but, rather, require a flexibility and discretion that render competitive bidding impractical and inefficient; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority, in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:
