

**Council Minutes**  
**Special Called Meeting**  
**April 29, 2024 - 6:30 p.m. - 502 Front St. E, Coeburn, VA**

**Attendees:**

Upon roll call, all members of Council were present. Jimmy Williams - Town Manager, Cathy Sharpe - Clerk/Treasurer, and William Sturgill - Town Attorney, were also present.

**Call to Order:**

Mayor Deventae Mooney called the meeting to order. Mr. Joe Still gave the invocation. The group remained standing for the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Mooney.

**Public Expression:**

There was no Public Expression.

Public expression was closed.

**Approval of the Agenda:**

Sharon Still made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Mr. Joe Still seconded the motion, which resulted in all Ayes.

**New Business:**

- A. Resolution 2024-005 - Mr. Maynard Spell, Center Director for Flatwoods Job Corps, spoke to Council about getting the center involved in the community. Mr. Spell said he is interested in developing some type of multi-purpose facility with meeting rooms and recreation areas. This would be available for community use. Mr. Spell would like to have some input from Council to see if they feel the facility would be a good fit for the community and if they have any ideas. Mr. Spell said if Council supports the idea, he will need a statement saying so and stating how the community would use the facility. Vice Mayor Sharon Still asked Mr. Spell if the support of the town was just verbal or if the town would be committed financially. Mr. Spell said that he would be submitting a request for funding to Congress. Mr. Sturgill, Town Attorney, said he tried to put something together but will make any changes needed. Mr. Jeff Kiser feels like anytime the town can support the Job Corps, it's a good thing to do. Mayor Mooney said he is happy to offer support for the facility. Mr. Sturgill read the Resolution he prepared in support of the multi-purpose community center for the Job Corps.

Mr. Jeff Kiser made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-005 in support of Flatwoods Job Corps soliciting funding for a multi-purpose community center. Ms. Sharon Still seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted as follows:

**Closed Session:**


There was no reason to go into Closed Session.
