

Council Minutes
Special Called Meeting
September 3, 2024 - 6:30 p.m. - 502 Front St. E, Coeburn, VA,

Attendees:

Upon roll call, the following members of Council were present: Deventae Mooney, Jeff Kiser, Joe Still and Sharon Still. Carles Collins was absent. Jimmy Williams - Town Manager, Cathy Sharpe - Clerk/Treasurer, and William Sturgill - Town Attorney, were also present.

Call to Order:

Mayor Deventae Mooney called the meeting to order. Mr. Joe Still gave the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Mooney.

Approval of Agenda:

Sharon Still made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Joe Still seconded the motion, which resulted in all Ayes.

New Business:

- A. Public Discussion of Brick Sidewalk by the Flatwoods Job Corps - Mr. Jeff Kiser was approached by Mr. Maynard Spell about the possibility of the Job Corps redoing the brick sidewalk by removing the brick and pouring concrete and stamping it with a similar brick design. The town would supply the materials, and the Flatwoods Job Corps would provide the labor. Mr. Kiser suggested that if Council so desires, Mr. Jimmy Williams, Town Manager, could reach out to Mr. Spell. Mr. Mooney said he would like to know the price of the concrete before reaching out to the Job Corps. Mr. Kiser said the scope of work would need to be known as well, to see how much area would be replaced. Mr. Williams could discuss this with Mr. Spell.

Ms. Still said she is interested in knowing about having the concrete repaired at the pool. She said the edge of the pool is in disrepair and worries that people will fall. Mr. Williams said he will discuss that with Mr. Spell as well. Any area of the sidewalk that adjoins a crosswalk will have to offer handicap access. Mr. Mooney asked Mr. Williams to gather the information and discuss it with Council.

Closed Session:

Mayor Deventae Mooney made a motion to enter into closed session in accordance with Virginia Code §2.2-3711 (A1) to discuss the performance of Town of Coeburn personnel specifically the Public Works Department. Sharon Still seconded the motion, which resulted in all Ayes.

Immediately following closed session, Mr. William Sturgill read "Certification of Closed Meeting," which is attached to these minutes and made a part hereof. A roll call vote certifying that only business matters that were identified in the motion convening were discussed or considered.
